Dear Microbiologics Customer,

The name of Microbiologics product 0907 (ATCC Licensed Derivative[®] ATCC[®] 49444^{™*}) has been changed from *Staphylococcus aureus* subsp. *aureus* to *Staphylococcus pseudintermedius*. ATCC[®] reported to Microbiologics that the name was changed because ribotyping and nucleotide sequence analysis of the 16s rRNA gene (GenBank FJ536211) and the sodA gene (GenBank FJ872832) indicated that this isolate is *Staphylococcus pseudintermedius*. This strain demonstrates the expected synergistic beta-hemolysis with *Listeria monocytogenes* in the CAMP test (FDA BAM).
