Dear Microbiologics Customer,

The name of Microbiologics product 0755 (ATCC Licensed Derivative® ATCC® 700323™*) has been changed from *Enterobacter cloacae* subsp. *cloacae* to *Enterobacter hormaechei*. ATCC® reported the microorganism was renamed based on a negative result for the 3-hydroxy-butyrate test.
