The name of Microbiologics product 0207 (ATCC Licensed Derivative® ATCC® 9179™*) has been changed from *Penicillium chrysogenum* to *Penicillium rubens*. ATCC® reported to Microbiologics that the name of ATCC® 9179™* was changed because the strain was reclassified as *Penicillium rubens* based on a recent molecular phylogenetic study.
