Dear Microbiologics Customer,

The name of Microbiologics product 0531 (derived from ATCC® 36031™*) has changed from *Fusarium solani* to *Fusarium keratoplasticum*. ATCC reported to Microbiologics that the name of ATCC® 36031™* was changed to *Fusarium keratoplasticum* in the *Fusarium solani* species complex based on the multigene sequence analysis.
