The name of Microbiologics product 0355 (ATCC Licensed Derivative® ATCC® 13315™*) has been changed from *Proteus vulgaris* to *Proteus hauseri*. ATCC® reported to Microbiologics that the name was changed because, based on DNA sequencing and biochemical test results, it was proposed and accepted that this strain belongs to the genus *Proteus* and the species *hauseri*.
