Recently, the name of Microbiologics product 0756 (ATCC Licensed Derivative® ATCC® 51329™*) was changed from *Enterobacter sakazakii* to *Cronobacter muytjensii*. ATCC® reported to Microbiologics that the name was changed because it was proposed and accepted that this strain belongs to the genus *Cronobacter* and the species *muytjensii*.
