The name of Microbiologics product 0698 (ATCC<sup>®</sup> 2601<sup>™\*</sup>) has been changed from *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* to *Saccharomyces kudriavzevii*. ATCC<sup>®</sup> reported to Microbiologics that ATCC<sup>®</sup> 2601<sup>™\*</sup> was renamed based on results of a polyphasic study which included biochemical tests, antifungal susceptibility tests, and multi-locus DNA sequence analyses.

The polyphasic study of *Saccharomyces kudriavzevii* ATCC<sup>®</sup> 2601<sup>™\*</sup> is described in detail in an ATCC<sup>®</sup> poster presented by Sung-Oui Suh, Brian Beck, Liz Kerrigan, and Jianlong Jim Zhou.
