The name of Microbiologics product 0235 (ATCC Licensed Derivative[®] ATCC[®] 7830^{™*}) is *Lactobacillus delbrueckii* subsp. *lactis*. More information concerning the name can be found in the List of Prokaryotic Names with Standing in Nomenclature (LPSN) by J. P. Euzéby.

According to Weiss et al. 1983, *Lactobacillus delbrueckii* subsp. *lactis* is a heterotypic synonym of *Lactobacillus leichmannii*. The reference is Weiss et al. *Lactobacillus lactis*, *Lactobacillus leichmannii* and *Lactobacillus bulgaricus* subjective synonyms of *Lactobacillus delbrueckii* subsp. *lactis* comb. nov. and *Lactobacillus delbrueckii* subsp. *bulgaricus* comb. nov. *Syst. Appl. Microbiol.*, 1983, **4**, 552-557.
