The name of Microbiologics product 0688 (ATCC Licensed Derivative<sup>®</sup> ATCC<sup>®</sup> 9341<sup>™\*</sup>) is *Kocuria rhizophila*.

The microorganism was formerly called *Micrococcus luteus*. The microorganism was reclassified because a polyphasic study indicated that ATCC<sup>®</sup> 9341<sup>™\*</sup> belongs to the genus *Kocuria*. The study combined molecular data with cytochemical properties and physiological characteristics.
